Dr. Chanam Lee is an Associate Professor of Landscape Architecture and Urban Planning in the College of Architecture at Texas A&M University.

Dr. Lee received her Ph.D. in Urban Design and Planning from the University of Washington.

She currently directs a research group, Design Research for Active Living, devoted to interdisciplinary research aimed at linking elements of the built environment with health behaviors and outcomes.

She is a fellow in the Center for Health Systems and Design, and adjunct faculty with the Department of Social and Behavioral Health.

Dr. Lee has published many prestigious papers in the planning/environmental/health journals and has been involved in a number of design and research projects funded by National Institute of Health, Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, American Institute of Architects, and Scott & White Hospital.
