## ♣ 강연 개요

Today the process of globalization is associated with the use of similar urban design and planning structures (downtowns, 'routine' modernism buildings), landscape architecture styles (global picturesque and gardenesque), and similar plant and construction materials. Lawn is one of the most powerful symbols of globalization today which covers up to 70 % of all open urban spaces. Urban biodiversity today can play an important role for ecological and cultural identity of cities around the world.

This lecture will explore existing approaches (case studies) in dealing with design of urban biodiversity in different countries around the globe such as Low Impact Development, alternative lawns and 'spontaneous vegetation'.
